➤ the monastic buildings of the abbey



From the garden to the refectory to the majestic terrace, the ruins of the monastic buildings are revealed as the restoration work undertaken since 2007 progresses. Its underground gallery (boat barns), stretching 70 metres along the river, and its landing stage at the water's edge, make it absolutely unique in France.
